Ipamorelin

A selective growth hormone secretagogue with a favorable safety profile.

- i** Ipamorelin is a selective growth hormone secretagogue (GHS) pentapeptide that activates the ghrelin/GHS receptor (GHSR-1a) on pituitary somatotrophs. Developed by Novo Nordisk in the 1990s, it is notable for its selectivity — stimulating GH release without significantly elevating cortisol, prolactin

HOW IT WORKS

1**Compound Class**

GH Secretagogue (Ghrelin Mimetic)

2**Half-Life**

~2 hours

3**Selectivity**

GH-specific (no cortisol/prolactin)

WHAT RESEARCHERS HAVE FOUND

Selective GH Release

Ipamorelin demonstrates dose-dependent GH release comparable to GHRP-6 but without significant increases in ACTH, cortisol, or prolactin, suggesting a more favorable side effect profile.

Bone Density

Animal studies indicate that ipamorelin increases bone mineral content and bone formation markers, suggesting potential applications in age-related bone loss.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFO

- Generally well-tolerated with minimal reported side effects
- Mild headache or lightheadedness may occur initially
- Injection site reactions are uncommon but possible
- Not recommended during pregnancy or with active malignancy
- Long-term safety data in humans is limited
